

Regular Session Minutes of the Council of the City of Dora, Alabama

July 22, 2014

The Council of the City of Dora, Alabama met in the Dora Municipal Building at 6:00 p.m. We were led in prayer by Pastor Gene Smith. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Randy Stephens.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Randy Stephens. Roll call was taken by Marcy Brown. Present at the meeting were, Robert Busby, Richard Lovelady, Clyde Nix, Betty Sanders, George Sides, Jr., Gary Thomas and Hezekiah Walker. A quorum was in attendance.

Item #11 –East Walker Sewer Authority—Discussion was made regarding the declining financial situation of the East Walker Sewer Authority and a workshop will be held at the city hall Tuesday, July 29, 2014 at 5 p.m.
