

Regular Session Minutes of the Council of the City of Dora, Alabama

December 8, 2015

The Council of the City of Dora, Alabama met in the Dora Municipal Building at 6:00 p.m. We were led in prayer by John Skalnik. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Randy Stephens.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Randy Stephens. Roll call was taken by Marcy Brown. Present at the meeting were, Robert Busby, Richard Lovelady, Clyde Nix, Betty Sanders, George Sides, Jr., Gary Thomas and Hezekiah Walker. A quorum was in attendance.

The minutes of the November 24, 2015 regular were reviewed. A motion was made by George Sides, Jr. to accept the minutes as written. The motion was seconded by Robert Busby. All in favor and motion carried.

Old Business

Mayor Stephens gave an update on the golf clubhouse, architect still working on finalizing the plans.

George Sides, Jr. made a motion to table Ordinance #10, 11, and 12, 2015 until we meet on December 14, 2015 for the workshop. Robert Busby seconded the motion.

After a discussion regarding the heaters for T.S. Boyd, Hezekiah Walker made a motion to purchase 4 heaters at a cost of \$8,600.00, Richard Lovelady seconded the motion.

Roll Call vote: Robert Busby –No; Richard Lovelady –Yes; Clyde Nix – No; George Sides, Jr. - Yes, Betty Sanders –Abstain; Gary Thomas – No; Hezekiah Walker – Yes; and Randy Stephens, No. The motion failed. 3 – Yes and 4 – No 1 – Abstain

Clyde Nix made a motion to purchase two heaters for T.S. Boyd at a cost of \$4,300.00 plus all remaining cost to install. Gary Thomas seconded the motion.

Roll Call vote: Robert Busby –Yes; Richard Lovelady –Yes; Clyde Nix – Yes; George Sides, Jr. - No, Betty Sanders –Yes; Gary Thomas – Yes; Hezekiah Walker – No; and Randy Stephens, Yes. The motion passed. 6 – Yes 2 - No

Item #7— Departmental Reports – Gary Thomas made a motion to approve all departmental reports as presented. Robert Busby seconded the motion. All in favor and the motion passed.

Item #8— Bill List - A motion was made by Clyde Nix to approve the bill list for 12/08/2015. The motion was seconded by Gary Thomas. All in favor and the motion passed.

Item #9 – Surplus Police Car Bids – Bids were opened on the 2008 Chevy Impala. Richard Lovelady made a motion to accept the highest bid of \$1,800.00 from Kevin Harrison. Clyde Nix seconded the motion. All in favor and the motion passed.

Item #10 – Toys for Tots Request – George Sides, Jr. made a motion to donate to Sumiton Fire and Rescue \$1,000.00 for Toys for Tots. Clyde Nix seconded the motion. All in favor and the motion carried.

Item #11 – Police Department Requests - George Sides, Jr. made a motion to purchase 4 new southern linc lines for the police department. Gary Thomas seconded the motion. All in favor and the motion carried.

Mayor Randy Stephens mentioned that the Burnwell CD had been closed out in the amount of \$57,403.09. The city would be given \$5,000.00 and the balance of the money would be returned to George Barber in the amount of \$52,403.09.

Gary Thomas made a motion to adjourn. Betty Sanders seconded the motion. All in favor and meeting adjourned.
