

ORDINANCE #9-2015

CITY OF DORA, ALABAMA

AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE CREEL LIMITS FOR CERTAIN SPECIES OF FISH AT THE DORA CITY LAKE

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Dora, Alabama, while in a regular session on the 23rd day of June, 2015 at 6:00 p.m. as follows:

SECTION 1. Creel Limits.

For the purposes of this Ordinance, the City of Dora hereby adopts the following creel limits that shall be placed on aquatic life within the body of water commonly known as “Dora City Lake” for all Bream, Bass, and Channel Catfish:

All Bream, Bass, and Channel Catfish, when taken or in the possession of a person after having been taken from the water of Dora City Lake, shall be as follows:

Species:	Limitation:
Bream	15 per day, no length limit
Bass	10 per day, no length limit
Catfish	3 per day, no length limit

SECTION 2. Prohibited Acts

- a. It shall be unlawful for any person, by fishing or other means, to keep, remove or destroy any of the species of fish specified in the preceding section which violates the creel limit.
- b. It shall be unlawful to trap baitfish, frogs, turtles, ducks, and other aquatic organisms.
- c. It shall be unlawful to release any fish, ducks, or aquatic organisms into the city lake without the consent of the city.

SECTION 3. Hours of Operation

Fishing shall only be allowed during the times the Dora City Lake area is open to the public. The hours of operation for Dora City Lake will be from daylight to dark and shall be posted in a conspicuous place around the lake area. There shall be no activity on the lake except as published.

SECTION 4. Penalties

Fine amounts will be set according to the State of Alabama Wildlife & Freshwater Fisheries Division.

SECTION 5. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon its adoption and publication or by its otherwise becoming a law.
