RESOLUTION RESOLUTION REGARDING BRUSH DISPOSAL AND REMOVAL

WHEREAS, The City is pleased to offer brush pickup for citizens within the corporate limits of Dora. and

WHEREAS, The regulations below have been placed on this service to ensure efficiency in cost and labor.;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Dora, that from and after July 13, 2017, the City of Dora adopts the following policy:

1. Brush / limbs up to 4 inches in diameter must be cut into lengths no greater than 6 feet long.
2. Brush / limbs up to 12 inches in diameter must be cut into lengths no greater than 24 inches long.
3. Any brush / limbs greater than 12 inches in diameter will **NOT** be picked up.
4. All brush must be dragged to within 6 feet of edge of road with large end of limbs toward the road.
5. No furniture, household items, or any other debris will be picked up.
6. No brush piles pushed up by a tractor, bulldozer, bobcat, or any other machinery will be picked up. The brush must be hand stacked.
7. Citizens must call City Hall at 648-3211 to request a pick-up. Work orders will be completed in the order they were received as time allows.
8. If a pile requires more than one load, the truck will come back to that pile after picking up other brush in the city first.
9. If a professional tree service is hired to take down a tree, the tree service is responsible for removal of brush.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED 1. During periods of severe weather, every effort will be made to clean up the city as soon as possible, including multiple trips to same address if needed.; and
