

**City of Dora**  
**ORDINANCE #2, 2010**

Be it ordained by the Council of the City of Dora, Alabama on this 10<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2010 during a regularly scheduled meeting, after discussion, a motion and a duly made second, the Council approved the following:

**WHEREAS**, the City of Dora Street and Sanitation Department provides pickup and disposal of residential and commercial garbage as a courtesy within the City of Dora, and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Dora would like to combine the residential and commercial routes, therefore eliminating the Friday pick up route, and thus saving the city in fuel cost and wear and tear on the garbage truck, and

**WHEREAS**, the collection of garbage shall be made at least once each week on Tuesday or Wednesday, depending on the route in which a street is located, and

**WHEREAS**, city employees will not go upon private property to collect garbage, and

**WHEREAS**, all trash must be bagged and placed inside garbage receptacles and be located at the street, alley, or right of way for collection service, and

**WHEREAS**, any business, commercial, institutional, or industrial location that disposes on a regular basis quantities greater than four garbage cans (120 gallons) shall be required to use a dumpster.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, beginning on September 7, 2010 all commercial businesses must comply with the rules set forth in this ordinance and shall have their garbage collected on the day of the route in which they are located.

This ordinance will take effect and be in force immediately after its legal publication.

**ADOPTED**, this the 10<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2010.
