**RESOLUTION #2-2018**

**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF DORA'S  
PARTICIPATION IN THE STATE OF ALABAMA  
SEVERE WEATHER PREPAREDNESS TAX HOLIDAY  
FOR THE YEAR 2018**

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**BE IT RESOLVED**, by the City Council of the City of Dora, Alabama as follows:

**Section 1.** Section 4 of Alabama Act No. 2012-256 grants municipal governments authority to provide for the exemption of certain covered items from the payment of municipal SEVERE WEATHER PREPAREDNESS TAX during a period commencing at 12:01 a.m. on February 23, 2018 and ending at twelve midnight February 25, 2018 under the same terms, conditions and definitions as provided for by the State of Alabama SEVERE WEATHER PREPAREDNESS TAX holiday.

**Section 2.** The City of Dora grants approval for the exemption of certain covered items from the payment of municipal SEVERE WEATHER PREPAREDNESS TAX for the period commencing at 12:01 a.m. February 23, 2018 and ending at twelve midnight February 25, 2018 under the same terms, conditions and definitions as provided for by Act No. 2012-256 and Alabama Department of Revenue Rule 11-51-210(e).

**Section 3. Covered Items:**

- **Batteries:** AAA, AA, C, D, 6-volt, 9-volt and cellphone batteries
- **Radio:** Self-powered or battery-powered radios, two-way radios, weatherband or NOAA weather radios
- **Self-powered light sources:** Battery-powered flashlights, lanterns and emergency glow sticks
- **Sheeting:** Plastic sheeting, drop cloths or other flexible and waterproof sheeting
- **Anchor systems:** Ground anchor systems, such as bungee cords or rope, or tie-down kits
- **Hardware supplies:** Duct tape, plywood, window film or other materials specifically designed to protect window coverings
- **Food and storage:** Non-electric food storage coolers or water storage containers, non-electric can openers, artificial ice, blue ice, ice packs and reusable ice
- **First aid and safety:** First-aid kits, fire extinguishers, smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors
- **Fuel:** Gas or diesel fuel tanks and containers

**The covered items must cost \$60 or less, except for generators, which are covered as long as they cost \$1,000 or less.**

**Section 3.** This Resolution shall become effective upon adoption.
