

Regular Session Minutes of the Council of the City of Dora, Alabama

March 23, 2017

The Council of the City of Dora, Alabama met in the Dora Municipal Building at 7:00 p.m. We were led in prayer by Mayor Randy Stephens. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Randy Stephens.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Randy Stephens. Roll call was taken by Marcy Brown. Present at the meeting was Phillip Ballenger, Marion Combs, Chris Edwards, Clyde Nix, McArthur Sargent, Arthur Lee Taylor and Mayor Randy Stephens. Randy Spears was absent. A quorum was in attendance.

Item #5— Approval of the Minutes - The minutes of the March 9, 2017 regular meeting and March 2, 2017 workshop meeting were reviewed. A motion was made by Clyde Nix to accept the minutes as written. The motion was seconded by Phillip Ballenger. All in favor and the motion was carried.

Item #6— Bill List - A motion was made by Chris Edwards to approve the bill list for 3/23/2017. The motion was seconded by Phillip Ballenger. All in favor and the motion passed.

Item #7 – Old Business

a. Sale of Clinic – McArthur Sargent made a motion to table the sale of medical clinic until a workshop could be held. Marion Combs seconded the motion. All in favor and the motion was passed.

Item #8 – Golf Course Items– Clyde Nix made a motion to approve the phone system quote from D.P. Communications at a cost of \$2,850.00. Arthur Lee Taylor seconded the motion. All in favor and the motion was carried.

Chris Edwards made a motion to approve the golf security system at a cost of \$2,109.76. Clyde Nix seconded the motion. All in favor, with the exception of Marion Combs who abstained, and the motion was carried.

Item #9 – Fire Department Request – Arthur Lee Taylor made a motion to approve the purchase of firehoses at a cost of \$5,595.00. This will be paid out of the fire account. Phillip Ballenger seconded the motion. All in favor and the motion carried.

Item #10 - Wrecker Rotation - Res# 12, 2013 – Mayor Stephens wanted the council to be informed of the current wrecker rotation policy the city has in place that the police department abides by. Any business wanting to be on the rotation list must have a current business license and have an impounding lot within the city limits of Dora.

Marion Combs made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Phillip Ballenger seconded the motion. All in favor and the meeting was adjourned.
