

Regular Session Minutes of the Council of the City of Dora, Alabama

August 24, 2017

The Council of the City of Dora, Alabama met in the Dora Municipal Building at 7:00 p.m. We were led in prayer by Hezekiah Walker. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Randy Stephens.

Item #9 – Golf Course Equipment – Arthur Lee Taylor made a motion to purchase used equipment for the golf course: fairway mower, rough mower, trim mower, truckster, and sand traps in the amount of \$115,800.00. Marion Combs seconded the motion. All in favor and the motion was carried.

Item #10 – Football Scoreboard Sign – Mayor Stephens informed the council that he had donated the J.D. fairway mower to Dora High School in exchange for them putting our sign on the scoreboard for at least 7 years. The golf course also donated the sandpro to the park and rec department for them to drag the fields.

Item #11 – Opening of Bids on Surplus Police Car- Since there were not bids on the surplus equipment, Mayor Stephens stated that we would sell to the most reasonable offer made on the car.

Arthur Lee Taylor made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Marion Combs seconded the motion. All in favor and the meeting was adjourned
