

Regular Session Minutes of the  
Council of the City of Dora, Alabama

February 26, 2026

The Council of the City of Dora, Alabama met in the Dora Municipal Building at 6:00 p.m. We were led in prayer by Pastor Zac Bozeman. Mayor Combs led the Pledge of Allegiance.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Combs. Roll call was taken by Stacy Turner. Present at the meeting were Robert Busby, Matt Diffy, Chris Edwards, John Jackson, George Sides, Jr., Gary Thomas and Mayor Combs. Randy Spears was absent. A quorum was in attendance.

**Item #5—Approval of the Minutes** - The minutes of the February 12, 2026 regular session meeting minutes and February 19, 2026 work session minutes were reviewed. A motion was made by Robert Busby to accept the minutes as written. The motion was seconded by John Jackson. All in favor and the motion carried.

**Item #6—Bill List** - A motion was made by Chris Edwards to approve the bill list dated February 25, 2026. Motion was seconded by Robert Busby. All in favor and the motion carried.

**Item 7-Old Business**-Mayor Combs related the new basketball backboards and correct rims were installed at the basketball court. The sod is being installed at Heritage Landing entrance by Drummond Company. Love's job fair on February 19-20 was successful with over one hundred applicants. The 2025 Fiscal Year Audit has been completed. The fire department was able to save approximately \$14,000 (fourteen thousand and no/100) in the cost for the new repeater which was approved last year.

**Item #8-Fire Hydrant**-Chris Edwards made a motion to approve the quote from Consolidated Pipe and Supply Company in the amount of \$6,028.04 (six thousand twenty-eight and 04/100) for a fire hydrant to service Mustard Seeds Preschool, Hillside Church and Sides Furniture. John Jackson seconded this motion. This will be purchased only if needed depending on where the new high school places their hydrants. All in favor and the motion carried.

**Item #9-Municipal Clerk Conference**-Gary Thomas made a motion to approve the City Clerk to attend the Alabama Association of Municipal Clerk's Summer Conference June 24-26, 2026 at Point Clear, AL in the amount of \$1,125.96 (one thousand one hundred twenty-five and 96/100). John Jackson seconded the motion. All in favor and the motion carried.

**Item#10-Resolution #3-2026**- Robert Busby made a motion to accept Resolution #3-2026-A Resolution to acknowledge receipt and acceptance of the 2025 fiscal year independent auditor's report from Kellum, Wilson and Associates, P.C. Matt Diffy seconded the motion. All in favor and the motion carried.
